## FUNDRAISING ACTIVITIES NOT ALLOWED ON UF CAMPUS

- Raffles or gambling
- Bake (or any food) sales
  - Flea Markets
  - Car Bashes
  - Date Auctions
- Food Eating Contests
  - Live Animals
- Slip-n-slide or homemade novelties
- Haircutting (except of Locks of Love done by the Reitz Union Hair Company)
  - Makeover
    - Credit card, telephone card, or discount card sales
  - Product sales such as magazines, clothes, CD's, or software, etc. (any commercial items not directly related to organization or event)
    - Garage sales w/ donated items
